Does my student need any previous experience before taking this class? Experience is preferred, but not necessary.

If my student attends this course, should they go to college or straight to the workforce?

Many opportunities to go straight into the workforce are available with a variety of options. Two and four-year programs also have an option for degrees such as Construction Management.

Are dual credits available when taking the Building Construction Technology course?

Yes, several are available and will be listed in the syllabus.

What expenses can I expect as a student?

Students will be required to purchase boots, safety glasses, hand tools, a tool belt, and a notebook.

What kind of salary can a person make with the skills learned in this program?

Wages range from \$15 per hour to \$50 per hour.
