

Computer Science FAQs

Does my student need any previous experience before taking this class?

No. The course starts off very basic and elevates through each semester. It was designed for students with no prior knowledge or experience.

If my student attends this course, should they go to college or straight to the workforce?

They can do either but it is recommended that they go to a two or four-year college to improve their chances for advancement and/or higher pay.

How much homework can a student expect from this course?

Typically there is at least one assignment a week, but most of our grades are through long term projects that combine multiple skills.

What expenses will I incur? Fees, book rental or purchase, tool costs, etc? There are no costs.

What is the job market for computer science?

Computer Science is a general study of computers which covers many disciplines. Of those disciplines, there is a tremendously growing job market for almost all of those fields. Our course mostly focuses on Software Development specifically Web and App and Data Analysis which is a huge market for any computer technology position.

What about college credits?

We currently offer fifteen (15) hours of dual credits with Ivy Tech Community College. These credits can be transferred to most four-year colleges in the state of Indiana.

Do I need to do well in Math and Science to excel in Computer Science?

No. Although it would help tremendously. It is recommended to have solid Algebra1 math skills, but if you have a great attitude, patience, and problem solving skills, CS is right for you.
